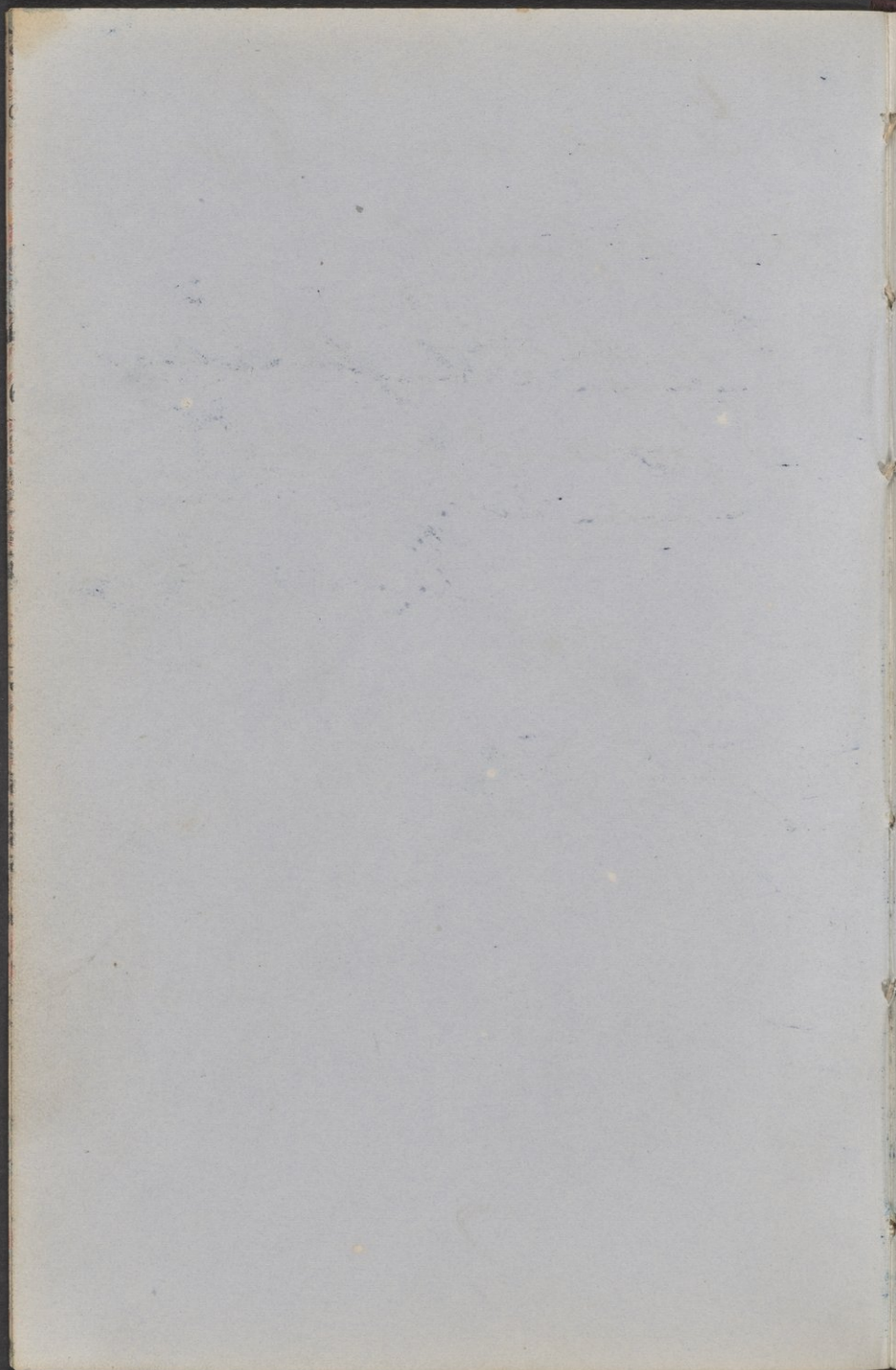

## Visit at Brighton

On the 6<sup>th</sup> of September, he left  
 Rushmore for Brighton, by the express  
 train at 12 past 9. He got into  
 a carriage, where there were three  
 gentlemen sitting back. They were  
 talking about the beauty of the  
 valley of Kent and that it was  
 called the Garden of England. When  
 we arrived at Brighton, he got out  
 and had great trouble to get the  
 Luggage, the Brighton Train was  
 already in and he was screaming  
 to every man we saw for our  
 luggage & that he were going  
 to Brighton then he could not  
 find the Gentles which they treated  
 in the most disrespectful way,  
 in spite of my saying with care,  
 He then went for our tickets

and they gave us only one  
and persisted in saying we  
had only asked for one; the  
guard screaming all the time  
you will be too late we at  
last got I and ran with  
all our might over the bridge  
and into a carriage, where there  
were a Lady and gentleman;  
after some little time the  
Lady perceived she had left  
a Book at the Regate Station,  
we all of us gave her excellent  
advice how to recover it; the  
gentleman not saying his until  
we had done ours, which was  
to telegraph for it. He had seen  
a Book lying on the counter  
at Regate: it was Miss Anckland's  
"Ladies of England" but one of  
the Ladies we heard of

screaming; a Lady was trying  
 to get into a Carriage when the  
 train was moving and kept ~~xxx~~  
 holding on by the door until the  
 Guard snatched her off. He went  
 through by Tunnels I think from  
 Ruislip to Brompton. Arrived  
 at Brompton. The man came  
 for our tickets; when to our  
 great surprise he cut & returned  
 our ~~s~~; and to our horror we saw  
 they were day tickets. Nature  
 took off her in a great fuss saying  
 she had not asked for day tickets  
 though we were surprised our  
 tickets were so much cheaper than  
 any body else. Mr. Glendinning  
 was at the Station and sent  
 us in a carriage while he looked  
 for the luggage. Our fellow travellers  
 joining us, the gentleman say-

ing it was very cold and the  
Lady that she hoped they  
should find her Book. Mr  
Glenning said he would  
speak to the Superintendent  
at the Station about our Day  
tickets and that he should have  
the difference returned. Mr & Mrs  
Glenning were both very kind,  
we had Luncheon at 10/ and  
took a walk with Mr  
Glenning on the Prince's pier.  
There was a very strong wind and  
the sea was very rough. We  
unpacked all our things and  
drest tea at 5/6. The Schoolroom  
is a very large room but new.  
Perhaps the children make such  
a noise one cannot do anything.  
It is a job to have to be with  
them all day.

Sept. 7<sup>th</sup> Wednesday

A beautiful day had break  
- just at 8 o' hardly ready for it  
I went out in the afternoon on the  
Beach.

Sept 8<sup>th</sup> Thursday

A very fine day. Went to see  
Mr. Fisher. Went Shopping. Saw  
the Pavilion which is now sold  
to the Brighton People. Wonder  
it was not built in a better si-  
-tuation so far from the sea, I there  
<sup>we</sup> can't see it from any of  
the windows. Went out in the  
Afternoon to Kemp Town and on  
the Beach trying to find valuable  
stones.

Sept 9<sup>th</sup> Friday

Mr. Glendinning went to bed  
yesterday morning. He walked  
on the Beach in the morning.

In the afternoon we drove from one  
end of Brighton to the other. We  
went on the Beach & the Chain  
Pass. I saw a party of Indians  
going in a boat, though the sea  
was very rough, for the boat  
went up and down dreadfully, I  
thought, they seemed to enjoy  
it very much. The sailor screamed  
out to us, who were watching  
them "going to California from"  
Sept 30<sup>th</sup> Saturday

Mr. Gleason came  
in and told us that the  
two women were coming at  
6 to stay till Monday. He went  
on the Beach and found a pretty  
stone shell I gave the ladies  
to put into a box for Adela by Monday.  
But at 6 we were very much  
surprised by a visit from Polly

They was staying at the Albion  
Papoo & hohla arrived soon after.

Philly dined here.

Sunday Sept 19<sup>th</sup>

Talked with Papoo & hohla to  
Kemp Town. Philly came at  
1 o' clock took hohla away with  
him. They bathed all over the  
Town and did not come home  
till 5 o' clock. In the evening Papoo  
told us a secret. Sept 19<sup>th</sup> was  
came to dinner.

Sunday Sept 20<sup>th</sup>

He rose rather late at Break-  
fast and did not want for tea  
and Dr. and Libby. Let her  
Papoo. Let down to breakfast  
and a band played. Let  
out soon after to fetch the crops and  
hohla. He & Dr. & Libby spending as  
we came up the steps. Talked

afterwards with Mrs. Glendinning  
& Hamington's & my child  
a child. Practised before Sunday  
Mrs Fisher came to see us. child  
came in with Papa & little  
before 10; she went to see the  
Duchess of Gloucester. After lunch  
some visitors came in the draw-  
ing room, & then we were there  
to be sent away as soon as  
possible - Papa & child sent  
away at 3. He went out driving,  
& Lily went sitting. He saw the  
Duchess of Gloucester driving before  
the Band came.

Tuesday Nov 13<sup>th</sup>

Went out in the morning &  
in the afternoon, but was caught  
in the rain and came back  
in a fly. The Band came in  
the evening. Sat in the drawing  
room

Tuesday Nov 14<sup>th</sup>

Heard from Adeline Miss Both  
Dent to see the Duchess of Gloucester &  
Lady Brownlow at the Bedford  
Hotel. It rained in the afternoon.  
Ada came in the evening to tea,  
we staid up to hear the Band.

Thursday Nov 15<sup>th</sup>

The Day of Thanksgiving, I went  
to Church in the morning, having  
back be sent Dr. & Mr. Fisher,  
they came in to see us. After  
dinner we went on the Pier  
both Ada & the children, it was  
very windy, we walked on the  
Beach Walk. Mr. D. & Ada  
went back to school.

Friday Nov 16<sup>th</sup>

Had our hair cut. Went out  
driving in the afternoon. Saw  
Capt. Snow. H

Saturday Nov<sup>r</sup> 14<sup>th</sup>

Went out shopping in the  
morning in search of knitted  
Silks. In one shop they  
were too dear; at Hamington's  
also they were too dear. As we  
were coming back there was  
a little boy selling Sugarplums.  
She was offering them to a Lady  
as she was getting in a Carriage  
and by accident <sup>she</sup> threw them  
down, but <sup>she</sup> took no notice of it  
and the poor little boy was  
crying, so we gave him a  
Shilling. We met Mrs. G's  
also. He bought some Silks  
from a Boy in the Street.

Mrs. G came to ask if I could  
go and drive with Miss Sherburne,  
as she & Miss were obliged to stay  
at home for the Barn Steerage.

I did not go. He went on the train  
 to see the gentleman both  
 the guitar. He did not play much.  
 I think he must be poor for he  
 saw the money box in the summer  
 house, and he saw him pick  
 it up. I am afraid he did not  
 get anything. Dr. Saunders  
 was here

Sunday Nov 18<sup>th</sup>

I went to church with Mrs. G.  
 Missy did not go. He came back  
 in a fly, it rained all day.

Monday Nov 19<sup>th</sup>

He went in the morning to  
 the Duchess of Gloucester, but she  
 could not see us; we went in the  
 open fly, we saw Mrs. Fisher sitting  
 and Lily, Mrs. Miss Saunders  
 walking. After lunch the children  
 went to Mrs. Cambridge's to tea

so we had a very quiet afternoon  
& no noise at tea. We went  
to see Mr. Fisher and went  
on the Chain Pier. The gentleman  
both the waiter said something  
to us, but we did not know what,  
so we asked him what he  
had said, & if he would accept  
a shilling, which he did &  
he sang us some very pretty  
songs.

Tuesday Nov 20<sup>th</sup>.

Went to Mr. Fisher dined here  
He went to the Opera & saw  
Lady Brownlow there

Wednesday Nov 21<sup>st</sup>

Went to see Mr. Davies  
in Sussex Sq. Went out driving  
in the afternoon.

Thursday Nov 22<sup>nd</sup>.

Went to the Duchess of Gloucester

she was just going out, so she  
could not see us. He went to see  
Holly Brown. Went on the  
Pier in the afternoon.

Friday Nov 23rd.

Went out early in the  
morning and heard the Band,  
& talked on the Pier, as he was  
coming back he saw the Gentlemen  
both the guitar playing. He heard  
some Ladies & Gentlemen  
saying that they had heard  
the Gentlemen say while  
he was talking up & down  
the end of the Pier "Oh my heart,  
my heart is breaking". He  
went to see Mrs. Fisher in the  
afternoon, she has finished  
the book & it looks beautiful  
He staid with her some time  
and tried twice to go on the

Saw both Mrs. Fisher, but  
it rained. It cleared up  
afterwards and we walked  
along the cliff with her. There  
was a great storm in the  
evening, such wind & rain.  
I stand with Mrs. Gooding  
& read to her. "The Hope of  
the Katchoffs" a very amusing  
& good fairy story. Dr. Sch  
Triloff moved to Miss Green's  
room.

Saturday. He had a letter  
from Papa in answer to mine  
I had written to him, about  
our stay here. He called on  
Dr. Fisher in the morning  
he was out; he came to us in  
the afternoon. Mrs. Hubbard  
etc arrived here today. Went  
out driving in the afternoon.

Sunday Nov 25<sup>th</sup>

He went to Church in the  
morning with Dr. J. At 2 o'clock  
he had a walk before Church.  
He went in the Drawing-room  
in the evening.

Monday Nov 26<sup>th</sup>

A very foggy morning, he  
could not see the Pier. In the  
afternoon he went to the Duke  
's Chamber & Apartment seeking  
for those he had seen the  
other day but he could not see them.

-Jital Ball tonight.  
Tuesday Nov 27<sup>th</sup>

This morning a parcel  
arrived from Uncle containing  
<sup>some</sup> beautiful books for us. Prof  
sent to London this morning  
but I have staid at home. He  
sent out in the afternoon.  
Wednesday Nov 28<sup>th</sup>

The Dressmaker came  
in the morning afterwards he  
walked to Kemp Town & on  
the slope. After dinner  
we went shopping and fetched  
my muff. He saw Prof &  
Mr. Trip Lambert riding.  
Practised the guitar in the  
evening.

Thursday Nov 29<sup>th</sup>  
He walked to Kemp  
Town, looked at some apartments

went on the Pier. Ada came  
to luncheon & went back in  
the evening.

Friday Nov 30<sup>th</sup>

St Andrew's Day, it grows on,  
we should have gone to church  
He dropped ourselves this morning,  
as I believe, I was not up. This  
is the first day we have not  
been out at all. He played with  
the children in the evening  
Saturday Dec 1<sup>st</sup>.

This morning we settled  
on some lodgings and took  
them, after having looked  
at a great many along the  
Parade. In the afternoon  
we bought a Doll for the children  
went to the Supermarket & Mrs.  
Tucker. At tea we put the  
Doll on the floor and called

it Lady Anacapa, the  
children really believing it to  
be a real live Fairy. She  
was very much frightened  
& so was I. He played  
at "For There & There".  
In mine I is deep in Dickens's  
"David Copperfield".

Sunday, Dec 2<sup>nd</sup>

A very wet day, so did not go  
to Church as he used to do.

He tried to amuse the  
children with the Doll, after  
dinner he went into the  
Drawing-room. In the evening  
a lot as he was frightened  
of the Fairy & that it did  
not amuse him & hoped  
he should take it away with  
us. I guess that altered his  
feelings towards us as before

We he liked it very much.  
 This is our last stay at  
 Fenwick House.  
 Monday Dec 2<sup>d</sup> 9<sup>th</sup>

He packed up & sent out  
 both Miss Venner & the children  
 & dined at 10 and very soon  
 soon after he went off in a  
 fly to our lodgings. Dr J  
 came to see us in the evening  
 before he sailed, he had a  
 letter from Adela. He all  
 went to bed early being tired  
 from having packed &  
 unpacked Mrs J came in  
 the morning to tell us of  
 the death of the Queen Dow.  
 Tuesday Dec 3<sup>d</sup> 9<sup>th</sup>

He breakfasted at 9 1/2 o'cl.  
 He did not go out in the morning  
 Dr J came to fetch us to

Lunch. He staid in the  
Schoolroom for half an hour  
then he went & ordered  
a Hans at Wrights to hire  
for a week. He went to the  
District Shop to buy Cheese-  
-Monger for some eggs. Then  
he came home he found  
Mr & Mrs Fisher had called  
& left their land which Dr.  
Sigwood gave us. After he  
had been in half an hour  
they called again & were here  
when the Hans came up  
stairs. Mr. Fisher asked us  
to dine with her Thursday.  
The Hans came in the  
evening.

Thursday Dec 25<sup>th</sup>

Then he broke the  
morning at 7 of the wind

was howling & the sea roaring.

It rained so much that people could not hold up their umbrellas.

He dined here to day as it rained so fast. He saw nevertheless a great many people on the Pier from Anversity I suppose to see the sea, which was most beautiful. such dunes?! once they went over the end of the Pier.

At 5 of the eve very much astonished by a visit from Mrs

J who kindly came here as well in the rain. He had a

letter from Madam. This is

the 3<sup>d</sup> bad day since he came here in Brighton &

Johns reading in the evening

in Duval de Trup's "Revue de

France" of Marie Antoinette,

she was born on the day of the

Earthquake at Lisbon in  
1755, it was a bad omen  
of her future life.  
Thursday Dec 26<sup>th</sup>

A most beautiful  
day, one could hardly have  
expected it after yesterday.

He did not go out till 10  
12 & he walked on the Brick  
Walk and then went home  
with Mr. Fisher. While we  
were at dinner she got a  
letter from Mr. Fisher telling  
her that they must go to  
town tomorrow for good little  
did poor Mr. Fisher expect  
the cause. He went to Laurie's  
in the old Stone Street on  
the Pier. He went all the  
day long there as well. I  
sighed & stone & so on

found, Mrs J<sup>d</sup> 13. We then  
 tried our luck at the Wheel  
 of Fortune; We got eighteen  
 pence; & we only got sixpence  
 or lost in other amusements.  
 You put in a shilling & the  
 highest 10 Shillings & the  
 lowest <sup>is</sup> a sixpence you can  
 gain. He had much difficul-  
 tly in finding something  
 for a sixpence; I got a  
 little too with a man  
 jumping out. We chose  
 home with Mrs Fisher  
 & then we went home. After  
 the Mr Fisher came & told  
 us poor Mrs Fisher's only sister  
 was dead; poor thing he was  
 staying till her till tomorrow.

Friday Dec 7<sup>th</sup>

It rained in the morning  
so I did not go out till Mrs G  
came to fetch us. As I was  
being ready I went with her,  
as Mr & Mrs I came afterwards,  
but there was such a high wind  
they could hardly get along, it  
was raining too, which made  
them very late. He staid  
& had tea with the children  
& came home in a fly. It  
was very stormy night. Miss  
Pen told us a very good  
sawdell "My first is irrational,  
my second rational; my third  
inanimate & my 4<sup>th</sup> is a  
science" Horsemanship.

Saturday Dec 8<sup>th</sup>

He went out very early  
to Kemp Town & then back

into the Town. He dined at  
Mr. Glendinning's & went to the  
Pier afterwards. In the evening  
I wrote three letters.

Sunday Dec 29<sup>th</sup>

A very fine morning  
went to Church rather late, therefore  
did not get a good seat. The Church  
was all pining with black. Mr  
Anderson preached such a  
nice sermon about Queen  
Adelaide; her whole life. He  
went to Trinity Church also.

The text in the morning was  
the 11<sup>th</sup> Chap of St John's Gospel  
& the 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> verses.

Monday Dec 30<sup>th</sup>

He recited all our com-  
-missions this morning in the  
Town. After Luncheon at the  
Glendinning's the children said

something that made I hope  
I speak to Mrs J. He went  
on the Sea then to Mrs  
Baldy. Coming back he got  
Butter, Coffee & Sugar & paid  
for different things, all in  
St James's St

Thursday Dec<sup>r</sup> 17<sup>th</sup>

He walked up to Kemp  
Town in the rain, but it was  
so mild he did not mind  
it. There were 18 at Luncheon  
today. He went for the Fish  
into the Town, but they had  
not got it; he been caught in  
the rain. He ordered some  
Shrimps for our breakfast  
tomorrow.

Friday Dec<sup>r</sup> 18<sup>th</sup>

He had the Shrimps,  
we walked to Kemp Town,

When we went to Luncheon  
 we asked the children to come  
 I have tea with us, but they  
 could not come. We walked  
 on the Brick Walk with the  
 Children.

Thursday Dec<sup>r</sup> 13<sup>th</sup>

We went out very early  
 on the Pier when we expected for us,  
 though there was Church today  
 but we must have mistaken  
 the Clergyman Sunday; we  
 walked to the German Spa.  
 Went to Mrs Baldy; Miss  
 Green came to tea. We met  
 Mrs & Miss Driver in the  
 morning walking.

Friday Dec<sup>r</sup> 14<sup>th</sup>

I had a letter from Papa  
 Mr. J. wrote to me to tell us Mr  
 J. wished us to dine with them

Though it did rain. He walked  
home in the rain, & began to  
pack up.

Saturday Dec 95<sup>th</sup>

A dreadful morning  
he did not know what to do  
about going to the Christmas  
see, at last went there in a  
Fly, but arrived there they  
had all done & were waiting  
for us, he & I went and  
sat to a little table by the  
window, after lunch it  
cleared up, he went on the  
Pier to see the Jewels, but she  
was not there. He went to  
know who saw us looking  
into a Confectioners Shop. In  
the French Shop he saw a most  
beautiful Christmas Tree, which  
is to be raffled for, there are

40 members, each to put in  
 2-6. He bought some Sugar  
 plums for the children. He had  
 a letter from Anna saying she  
 hoped we should stay a week  
 longer, so I wonder where we shall  
 be next Monday night. While  
 I am writing at 8 and now  
 just come.

Sunday Dec<sup>r</sup> 16<sup>th</sup>

A bad day again, we could  
 hardly make up our mind to go  
 to church; but we did go in a fly.  
 I had a letter from Papa saying  
 we were to go home Monday.  
 There was the annual subscription  
 today at church for the Hospital.  
 We walked on the Pier in the  
 afternoon & spent the rest of the  
 day with the Quakers, who  
 were all so kind to us. We came

home in a Fly but it being a  
bad night it was a long time  
before we could get one. The  
Coachman dropped his whip coming  
along & he was a long time  
before he could find it, but  
last day in Brighton has  
been a very pleasant one.  
Monday Dec 2 17th

We got up very early and  
went out at 9 o'clock went on the  
Dier to the West Cliff & then  
again on the Pier where Dr  
J came after us & walked  
with us. it was the most  
beautiful day since we had  
been in Brighton; the sea was  
so high & beautiful. We left  
our Locking at 4 1/2 10 o'clock  
& Mrs Sigwood was very  
well & hoped they should

see us again in Brighton &  
 in their house. When he arrived  
 at the Station he had plenty of  
 time to get our Tickets comfor-  
 tably. When the train was  
 just setting off I saw I perceived  
 that she had left her umbrella  
 - in the cab but there was no  
 help for it, it was too late.  
 Our fellow travellers were a  
 Lady & Gentleman, but they  
 suddenly said a word, therefore  
 not so agreeable as those we  
 went to Brighton with. We got  
 a Regent at 12 of whom we  
 dined for 2 hours. We walked  
 about & went to the Hotel for  
 some soup. We saw John at  
 the Station. From Regent  
 to Puckinest we had an old  
 gentleman in the Carriage

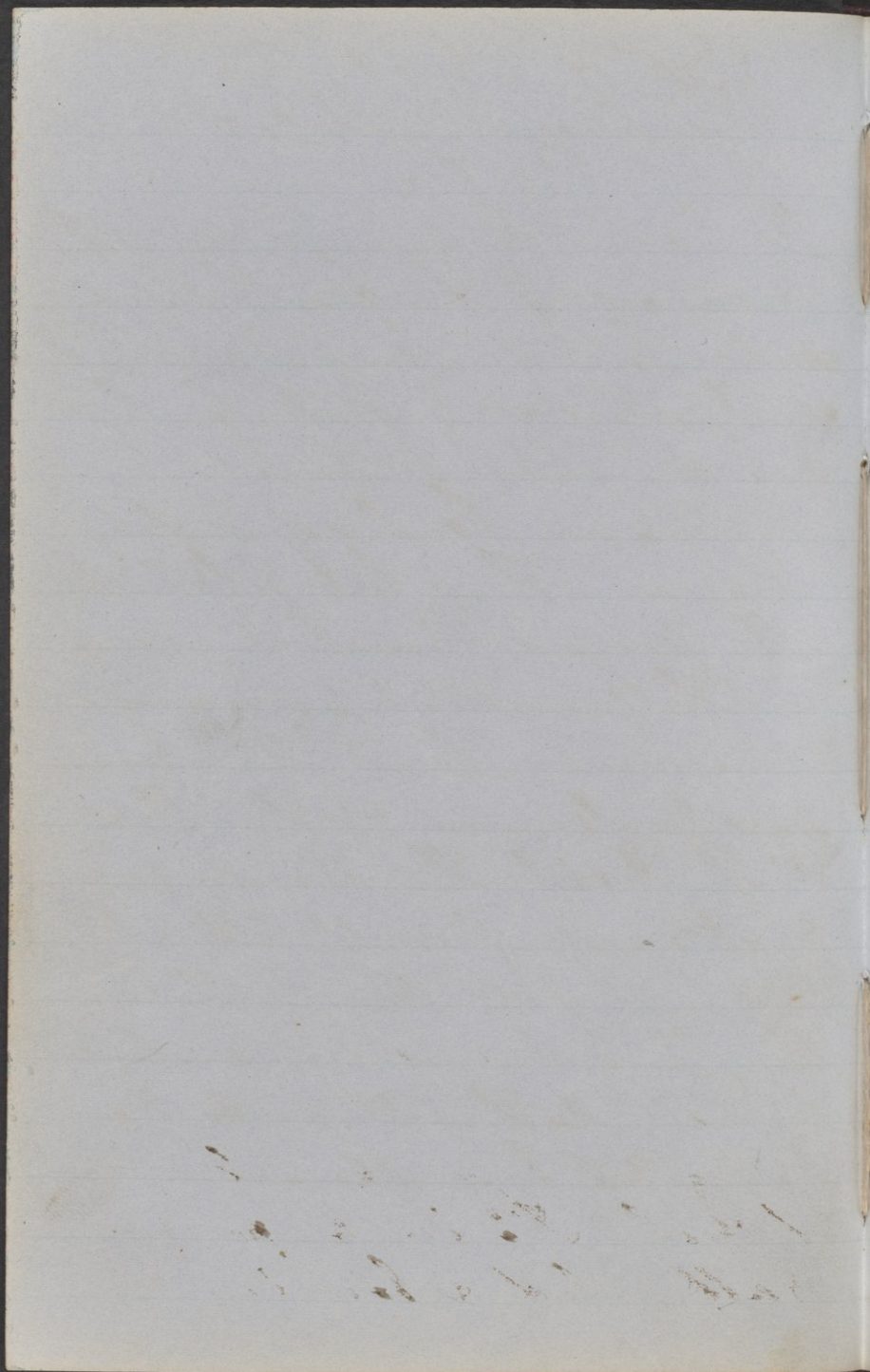
The Carriage was at Southport  
to meet Mr. Pully's dog,  
Remained at Southport &  
went to see Mr. Gerrard &  
the Bird who were quite  
well. We then went up  
stairs & found Marie  
gone! which surprised  
us very much. I also & whole  
checked at 7 o'clock. We saw in  
the paper Pully's marriage  
therefore our secret is no  
longer one. Having finished  
our travels & arrived safely  
home my journal is  
finished!

## Recipe for Black Pudding

To make Black Pudding  
 The blood must be stirred  
 with salt till cold. Soak  
 all night a quart of bruised  
 groats in as much boiling  
 hot milk as will swell them  
 & leave half a pint of liquor  
 Chop a good quantity of  
 pennyroyal, Savory &  
 Thyme; salt, pepper  
 & Allspice finely powdered.

Mix these with a quart  
 of blood; then half fill  
 the skins, after they have  
 been thoroughly cleaned,  
 & put as much of the inward  
 fat of the pig as will make  
 it rich. Tie in links, only  
 half filled, & boil in a

Large kettle, picking them  
as they swell, or they will  
burst. When boiled lay  
between clothes & hang.  
When to be used, scald  
a few minutes in water  
before I put in a Dutch  
brew. See 29th/50
