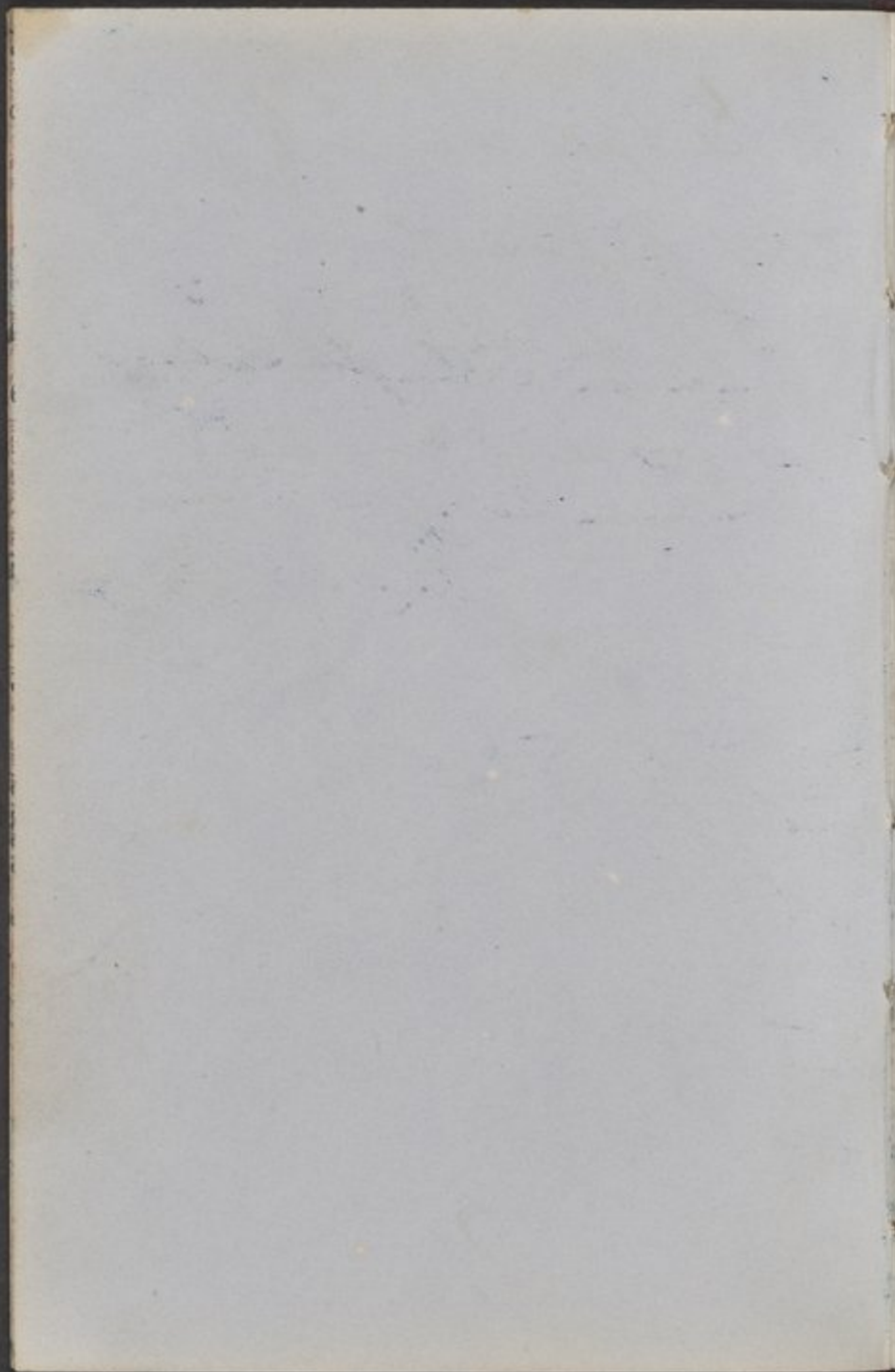

Visit at Brighton

On the 6th of September, we left
 Rushmore for Brighton, by the express
 train at 12 past 9. We got into
 a carriage where there were three
 gentlemen sitting back. They were
 talking about the beauty of the
 valley of Kent and that it was
 called the Garden of England. When
 we arrived at Brighton, we got out
 and had great trouble to get the
 Luggage, the Brighton Train was
 already in and we were screaming
 to every man we saw for our
 luggage & that we were going
 to Brighton then we could not
 find the Gent who they treated
 in the most disrespectful way,
 in spite of my saying with care,
 He then went for our tickets

and they gave us only one
and persisted in saying we
had only asked for one; the
guard screaming all the time
you will be too late we at
last got I had run with
all our might over the bridge
and into a carriage, where there
were a Lady and gentleman;
after some little time the
Lady perceived she had left
a Book at the Regate Station,
we all of us gave her excellent
advice how to recover it; the
gentleman ~~did~~ ^{spare} his until
we had done ^{for} which he
telegraphed for it. He had seen
a Book lying on the counter
at Regate: it was Miss Strickland's
"Lives of England" but one of
the Authors we heard of

streaming; a Lady was trying
 to get into a Carriage when the
 train was moving and kept ~~her~~
 holding on by the door until the
 Guard snatched her off. He went
 through by Tunnels I think from
 Gubniet & Brighton. Arrived
 at Brighton. The man came
 for our tickets; when to our
 great surprise he cut & returned
 ours; and to our horror we saw
 they were day tickets. Patricia
 took off her hat in a great fuss saying
 she had not asked for day tickets
 though we were surprised our
 tickets were so much cleaner than
 any body else. Dr. Glendinning
 was at the Station and put
 us in a carriage while he looked
 for the luggage. Our fellow travellers
 judging us, the gentleman say-

ing it was very cold and the
Lady that she hoped they
should find her Book. Mr
Glenning said he would
speak to the Superintendent
at the Station about our Day
tickets and that we should have
the difference returned. Mr & Mrs
Glenning were both very kind,
we had Lunccheon at 10/4
and took a walk with Mr
Glenning on the Prince's pier.
There was a very strong wind but
the sea was very rough. We
unpacked all our things and
drat the at 5/4. The Schoolroom
is a very large room to be sure.
= Perhaps the children make such
a noise we cannot do anything.
It is a job to have to be with
them all day.

Sept. 7th Wednesday

A wonderful day had break
just at 8 o' hardly ready for it
I went out in the afternoon on the
Beach.

Sept 8th Thursday

A very fine day. Went to see
Mr. Fisher. Went Shopping and
the Pavilion which is now sold
to the Brighton People. Wonder
it was not built in a better si-
tuation so far from the sea, I there
^{we} could see it from any of
the windows. Went out in the
Afternoon to Kemp Town and on
the Beach trying to find valuable
stones.

Sept. 9th Friday

Mr. Glendinning went to bed
yore this morning. He walked
on the Beach in the morning.

In the afternoon we drove from one
end of Brighton to the other. We
went on the Beach & the Chain
Pass. I saw a party of Indians
going in a boat, though the sea
was very rough, for the boat
went up and down dreadfully, I
thought, they seemed to enjoy
it very much. The sailor screamed
out to us, who were watching
them "going to California soon"
Sept 30th Saturday

Mr. Goodwin came
in and told us that the
were coming here tomorrow
& to stay till Monday. He went
on the Beach and showed a pretty
stone which I gave the Captain
to put into a box for Adela by Monday.
But he & I were very much
surprised by a visit from Polly

They was staying at the Albion
 Papa & hohla arrived soon after.

Philly dined here.

Sunday Sept 19th

Talked with Papa & hohla to
 Kemp Town. Philly came at
 1 o' and took hohla away with
 him. They bathed all over the
 town and did not come home
 till 5 o'. In the evening Papa
 told us a secret. Sept 19th
 came to dinner.

Sunday Sept 20th

He came rather late at Break-
 -fast and did not wait for the
 and Mr. and Libby. Let her
 Papa. Let down to breakfast
 and a band played. Let
 out soon after to fetch the crops and
 hohla Pa & Mr. Spendering as
 we came up the steps. Talked

afterwards with Mrs. Glendinning
& Hamington's & my Adela
a visit. Practised before Sunday
Mrs Fisher came here as Adela
came in with Papa a little
before 10; she went to see the
Duchess of Gloucester. After lunch
some visitors came in the draw-
ing room, & then we were there
to be sent away as soon as
possible - Papa & Adela sent
away at 3. I went out driving,
& Lily went sitting. I saw the
Duchess of Gloucester driving before
the Band came.

Tuesday Nov 13th

Went out in the morning &
in the afternoon, but was caught
in the rain and came back
in a fly. The Band came in
the evening. Sat in the drawing-
room

Tuesday Nov 14th

Had from Adeline Miss Both
Dent to see the Duchess of Gloucester &
Lady Brownlow at the Bedford
Hotel. It rained in the afternoon.
Ada came in the evening to tea,
we staid up to hear the Band.

Thursday Nov 15th

The Day of Thanksgiving, I went
to Church in the morning, having
back be sent Mr & Mrs Fisher,
they came in to see us. After
dinner we went on the Pier
both Ada & the children it was
very busy, we walked on the
Dick Lark. Mr & Mrs Fisher
went back to school

Friday Nov 16th

Had our hair cut. Went out
driving in the afternoon. Saw
Capt. Snow. H

Saturday Nov^r 14th

Went out shopping in the
morning in search of knitted
Silk. In one shop they
were too dear; at Harrington's
also they were too dear. As we
were coming back there was
a little boy selling Sugarplums.
She was offering them to a Lady
as she was getting in a Carriage
and by accident ^{she} threw them
down, but ^{she} took no notice of it
and the poor little boy was
crying, so we gave him a
Shilling. We met Mrs. G's
Mamma. He bought some Silk
from a Boy in the Street.
Mrs. G came to ask if I could
go and drive with Miss Barbara,
as she & Miss were obliged to stay
at home for the Baron's sickness.

I did not go. He went on the Chair
 Pier, we saw the gentleman with
 the guitar. He did not play much,
 I think he must be gone for he
 saw a money box in the summer
 house, but he saw him pick
 it up. I am afraid he did not
 get anything. Dr. Saunders
 was here

Sunday Nov 18th

I went to Church with Dr. & J
 Philippa did not go. He came back
 in a Fly, it rained all day.

Monday Nov 19th

He went in the morning to
 the Duchess of Gloucester, but she
 could not see us; we went in our
 open Fly, we saw Dr. Fisher sitting
 and Lily, Dr. & Miss Saunders
 walking. After lunch the children
 went to Dr. Chamberlaine's to tea

so we had a very quiet afternoon
& no noise at tea. We went
to see Dr. Fisher and went
on the Chain Pier. The gentleman
both the waiter said something
to us, but we did not know what,
so we asked him what he
had said, & if he could accept
no shilling, which he did &
he sang us some very pretty
songs.

Tuesday Nov 20th.

Dr. & Dr. Fisher dined here
We went to the Opera & saw
Lady Brownlow there

Wednesday Nov 21st

Went to see Mrs. Morier
in Sussex St. Went out driving
in the afternoon.

Thursday Nov 22nd.

Went to the Duchess of Gloucester

she was just going out, so she
could not see us. He went to see
John Brown. Went on the
Pier in the afternoon.

Friday Nov 23rd.

Went out early in the
morning and heard the Band,
& walked on the Pier, as he was
coming back he saw the gentlemen
with the guitar coming. He heard
some ladies & gentlemen
saying that they had heard
the gentlemen say while
he was walking up & down
the end of the Pier "Oh my heart,
my heart is breaking". He
went to see Mrs Fisher in the
afternoon, she has finished
the work & it looks beautiful.
He staid with her some time
and tried twice to go on the

Saw both Mrs. Fisher, but
it rained. It cleared up
afterwards and we walked
along the cliff with her. There
was a great storm in the
evening, such wind & rain.
I stood with Mrs. Goodwin
& read to her. "The Hope of

Saturday. We had a letter
from Papa in answer to mine
I had written to him, about
our stay here. He called on

He went to Church in the

& Duchess's Apartment seeking
for those he had seen the
other day but he could not see them.

Tuesday Nov 27th

This morning a parcel
arrived from Uncle containing
^{some} beautiful books for us. Dr J
sent to London this morning
Pa & Mrs stood at home. He
sent out in the afternoon.
Wednesday Nov 28th

The Dressmaker came
in the morning afterwards he
walked to Temple Street on
the slope. After dinner
we went shopping and fetched
my snuff. He saw Dr J
& Miss Lambert riding.
Practised the guitar in the
evening.

Thursday Nov 29th
He walked to Temple
Town, looked at some Apartments

I went on the Pier. Ada came
to luncheon & went back in
the evening.

Friday Nov 30th

St Andrew's Day, it grows on,
we should have gone to church
He dropped ourselves this morning
as I believe I was not up. This
is the first day we have not
been out at all. He played with
the children in the evening

Saturday Nov 1st

This morning we settled
on some stockings and took
them, after having looked
at a great many along the
Parade. In the afternoon
we bought a Doll for the India
went to the Supermarket and Mrs
Tidder. At tea we put the
Doll on the floor and called

it Lady Anacapa, the
children really believing it to
be a real live Fairy. Alice
was very much frightened
& so was I. He played
at "For There & There".
In Alice's I is deep in Dickens's
"David Copperfield".

Sunday, Dec 2nd

He very early, he did not go
to Church as he used to do.
He tried to amuse the
children with the Doll, after
dinner he went into the
Drawing-room. In the evening
I told us he was frightened
of the Fairy & that it did
not amuse him & hoped
he should take it away with
us. I guess that altered his
feelings towards us as before

We he liked it very much.
 This is our last day at
 Tamworth House.
 Monday Dec 3rd

He packed up & sent out
 both Miss Tenner & the children
 & dined at 10 and very soon
 soon after he went off in a
 fly to our lodgings. Dr J
 came to see us in the evening
 before he left, he had a
 letter from Hilda. He all
 went to bed early being tired
 from having packed &
 unpacked Mrs J came in
 the morning to tell us of
 the death of the Queen Dow.
 Tuesday Dec 4th

He breakfasted at 9/2 P.M.
 He did not go out in the morning
 Dr J came to fetch us to

Lunch. He staid in the
Schoolroom for half an hour
then he went & ordered
a Piano at Wrights to hire
for a week. He went to the
District Shop to the Cheese-
-monger for some eggs. Then
he came home he found
Mr & Mrs Fisher had called
& left their card which Mrs
Sigwood gave us. After he
had been in half an hour
they called again & were here
when the Piano came up
stairs. Mr Fisher asked us
to dine with her Thursday
The Band came in the
evening.

Thursday Dec 25th

Then he broke the
morning at 7 of the wind

was howling & the sea roaring.
It rained so much that people
could not hold up their umbrellas.

He dined here to day as usual
so hot. He saw nevertheless
a great many people on the
Pier from Curiosity I suppose
to see the sea which was most
beautiful. such waves!! once
they went over the end of the Pier.

At 5 of the eve very much
astonished by a visit from Mrs
& she kindly came here in
all in the rain. He had a
letter from Madam. This is
the 3^d bad day since he
came here in Brighton &
I was reading in the evening
in Du Roule's "Revue de
France" of Marie Antoinette,
she was born on the day of the

Earthquake at Lisbon in
1755, it was a bad omen
of her future life.

Thursday Dec 26th

A most beautiful
day, one could hardly have
expected it after yesterday.

He did not go out till 10
12 & he walked on the Brick
Walk and then went home
with Mr. Fisher. While we
were at dinner she got a
letter from Mr. Fisher telling
her that they must go to
him tomorrow for good little
did poor Mr. Fisher respect
the cause. He went to Spence's
in the old Steine & then on
the Pier. He went all & she
sighed & she as well. I

found, Mrs J^d 18. He then
 tried our luck at the Wheel

Friday Dec 7th

It rained in the morning
so I did not go out till Mrs G
came to fetch us. As I was
being ready I went with her,

they could hardly get along, it
was raining too, which made
them very late. He staid
& had tea with the children
& came home in a fly. A
very stormy night. Miss
Penny told us a very good
anecdote "My first is maternal,
my second rational; my third

Saturday Dec 8th

He went out very early
to Kemp Town & then back

into the Town. He dined at
Mr. Glendinning's & spent the
Even Afterwards. In the Evening
I wrote three letters.

Sunday Dec 29th

A very fine morning
went to Church rather late, therefore
did not get a good seat. The Church
was all pined with black. Mr
Anderson preached such a
fine sermon about Queen
Adelaide; her whole life. He
went to Trinity Church also.

The Text in the morning was
the 11th Chap of St John's Gospel
& the 26th & 27th verses.

Monday Dec 30th

He recited all our Com-
-munion this morning in the
Town. After Luncheon at the
Glendinning's the children said

something that made I hope
I speak to Mrs J. He went
on the 2^d then to Mrs
Baldy. Coming back he got
Butter, Coffee & Sugar & paid
for different things, all in
St James's St.

Thursday Dec^r 17th

He walked up to Kemp
Town in the rain, but it was
so mild he did not mind
it. There were 18 at Luncheon
today. He went for Mushrooms
into the Town, but they had
not got it; he been caught in
the rain. He ordered some
Shrimps for our breakfast
tomorrow.

Friday Dec^r 18th

He had the Shrimps,
and walked to Kemp Town,

When we went to church on
 we asked the children to come
 I have tea with us, but they
 could not come. We walked
 on the Brick Walk with the
 Children.

Thursday Dec^r 13th

We went out very early
 on the Pier when we had for us,
 though there was Church today
 but we must have mistaken
 the Clergyman Sunday; we
 walked to the German Spa,
 went to Mrs Baldy's. Miss
 were came to tea. We met
 Mrs & Miss Driver in the
 morning walking.

Friday Dec^r 14th

I had a letter from Papa
 Mr. J. wrote to me to tell us
 I wished us to dine with them

Though it did rain. He walked
home in the rain, & began to
pack up.

Saturday Dec. 95th

A dreadful morning
he did not know what to do
about going to the Gardinings,
so at last went there in a
Hij, but arrived there they
had all done & were waiting
for us. So I & John went
just to a little table by the
window. After lunch it
cleared up, he went on the
Pier to see the Jews, but she
was not there. He went to
know who saw us looking
into a Confectioners Shop. In
the French Shop he saw a most
beautiful Christmas Tree, which
is to be raffled for, there are

40 Members, each to put in
 2-6. He bought some Sugar
 plums for the children. He had
 a letter from Anna saying she
 hoped he should stay a week
 longer, so I wonder where he shall
 be next Monday night. While
 I am writing at 8 and he
 just came.

Sunday Dec^r 16th

A bad day again, he could
 hardly make up one mind to go
 to Church; but he did so in a Fly.

 He walked on the Pier in the
 afternoon & spent the rest of the
 day with the Quakers, who
 were all so kind to us. He came.

bad night it was a long time
before we could get one. The
Coachman kept his wife coming
along & he was a long time
before he could find it, but
last day in Brighton has
been a very pleasant one.
Monday Dec 2 17th

We got up very early and
went out at 9 o'clock on the
pier to the West Cliff & then
again on the pier where Dr
J came after us & walked
with us. It was the most
beautiful day since we had
been in Brighton; the sea was
so rough & beautiful. We left
our looking at 4 1/2 10 o'clock. Dr
& Mrs Bigwood were very
well & hoped they should

see us again in Brighton &
 in their house. When he arrived
 at the Station he had plenty of
 time to get our Tickets comfort-
 ably. When the train was
 just setting off, ^{Mr. James} Spencer

 gentleman in the carriage

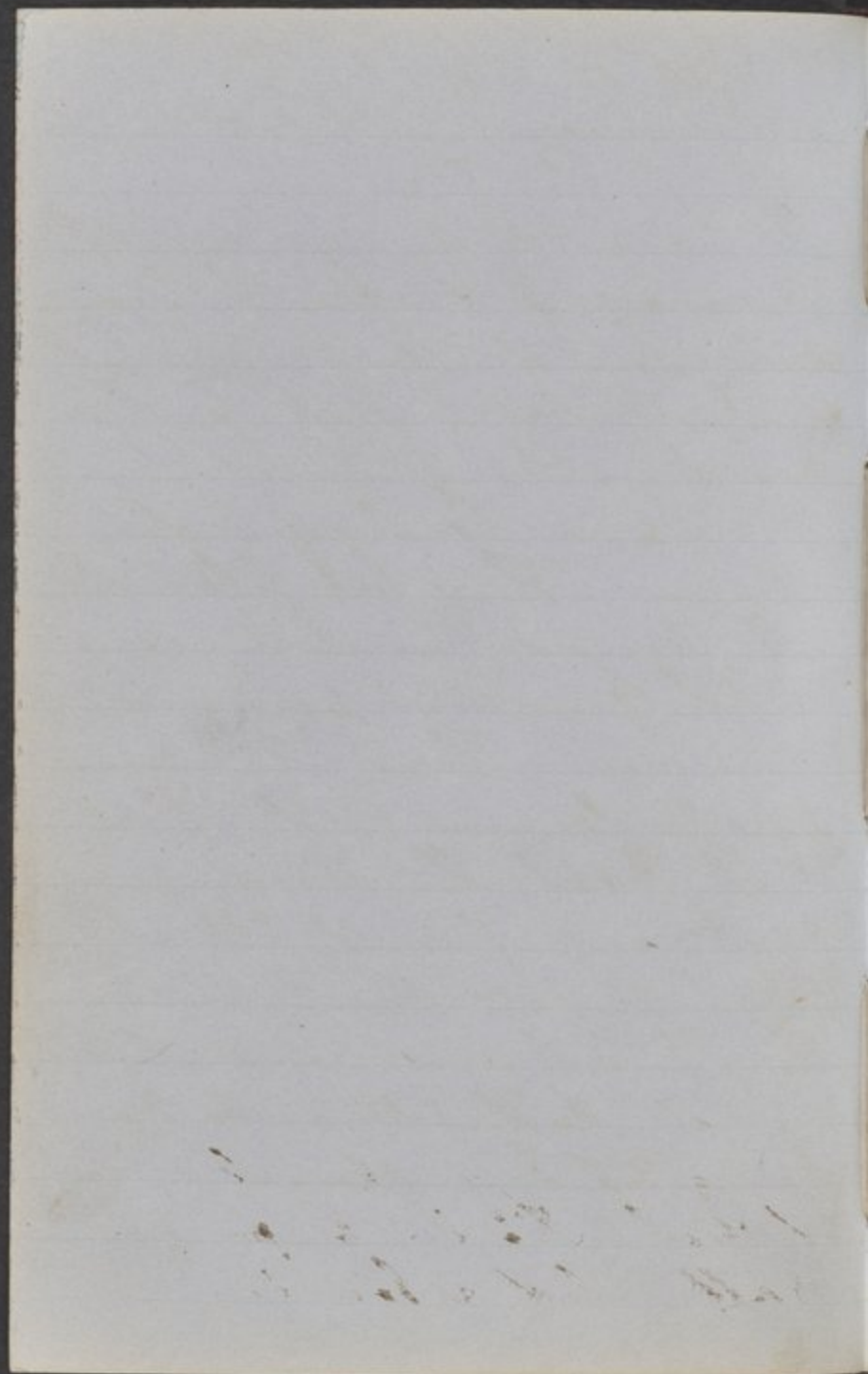
The Carriage was at Southport

Recipe for Black Puddings

To make Black Puddings
 The blood must be stirred
 with salt till cold. Soak
 all night a quart of bruised
 groats in as much boiling
 hot milk as will swell them
 to leave half a pint of liquor
 Chop a good quantity of
 poundage, marrow &
 thyme; salt, pepper
 & allspice finely powdered.

Mix these with a quart
 of blood; then half fill
 the skins, after they have
 been thoroughly cleaned,
 & put as much of the inward
 fat of the pig as will make
 it rich. Tie in links, only
 half filled, & boil in a

Large Kettle, picking them
as they swell, or they will
burst. When boiled lay
between clothes & hang.
When to be used, scald
a few minutes in water
