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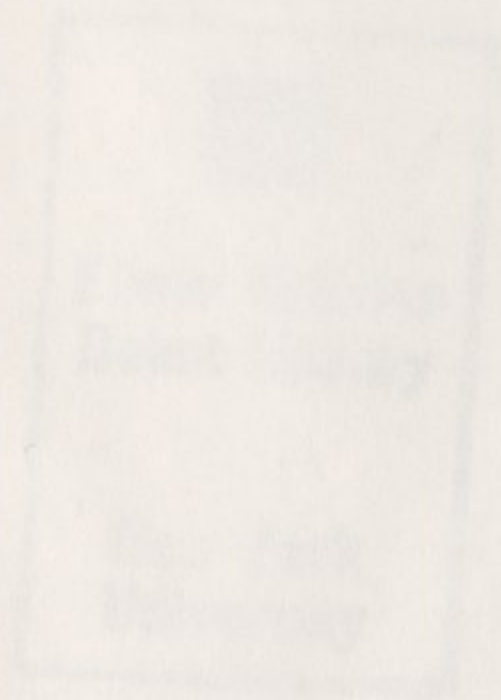
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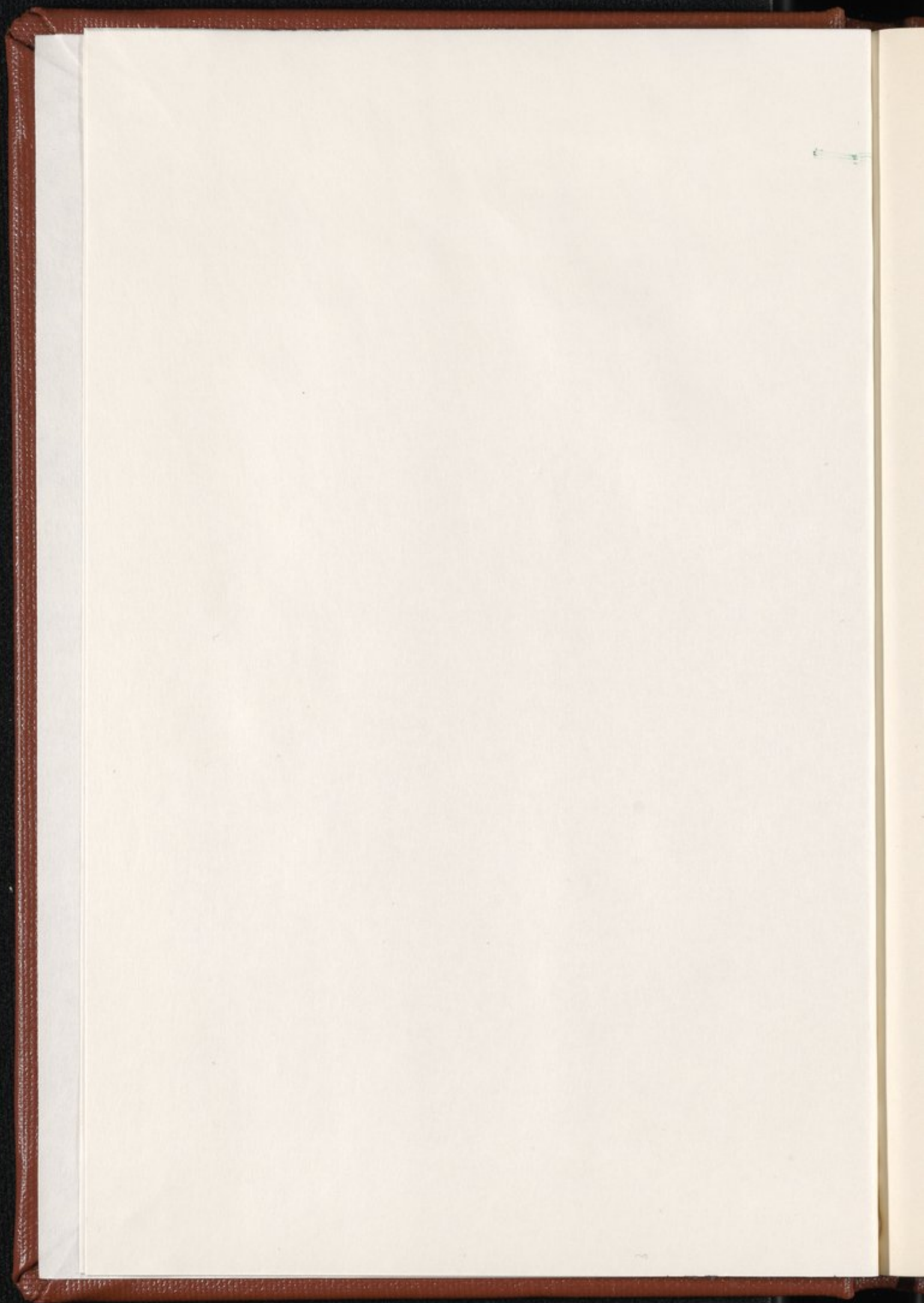

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PREFACE

The present work is intended as a supplement to our *Chronological Systems of Byzantine Egypt* (Stud.Amst. 8, Zutphen 1978), in which we dealt with the indiction system, consular dating, and the eras of Oxyrhynchos and of Diocletian. Regnal dating does not for the most part pose any major problems of calculating dates, but it seems to us that a collection of the material concerning the imperial formulas found from Diocletian to Heraclius might be of some use. We have found, in particular, that after A.D. 537 there are marked differences in the formulas used in one area from those used in another, and we have tried to make these regional idiosyncrasies stand out in our treatment.

In many ways this little volume will serve for the period from 284 to 641 the purposes that Bureth's *Les titulatures impériales* serves for the period of the principate. Some differences must be noted. Bureth had to deal with a much larger number of such dating clauses than we have, and we have therefore felt able to give more detail about ours. Secondly, as in other areas of Byzantine chronology, critical work on numerous documents has been necessary. The results are embodied in notes and in a series of articles published separately. Finally, we must stress that we take for granted that the user has *Chronological Systems (CSBE)* at his disposal; we do not repeat information found there. In cases where the date of a document according to the indiction and that according to the regnal year differ, we normally give the indictional date in the main entry, the regnal in a note; we consider that the indiction is usually the more accurate, but in any given case that may be erroneous. We have treated this problem in more detail in an installment of *CNBD* (V 62; see p.ix for bibliographical abbreviations).

It would be nothing short of astonishing if our collection of material were not incomplete. Editors of volumes have been remarkably slipshod about indexing regnal years not attached to a formula, even in otherwise exemplary volumes published in recent decades. We can only appeal for greater completeness of indexing in the future and ask our users to communicate to us those citations which we have missed.

As in *CSBE* we have incurred numerous obligations to those colleagues who have generously provided us with photographs, photocopies, drawings and their own readings in the course of our critical work. We must mention particularly J. Bingen, R.A. Coles, I.F. Fikhman, A.E. Hanson, H. Harrauer, J.G. Keenan, T.S. Pattie, R. Pintaudi, G. Poethke, J.R. Rea, J. Schwartz, R. Seider, P.J. Sijpesteijn and H.C. Youtie; to all we extend our thanks. The reader for the American Society of Papyrologists helped eliminate many small errors and inconsistencies. A generous grant from the Netherlands Organization for the Advancement of Pure Research (ZWO) made possible a visit by Worp to New York in the final stages of our work.

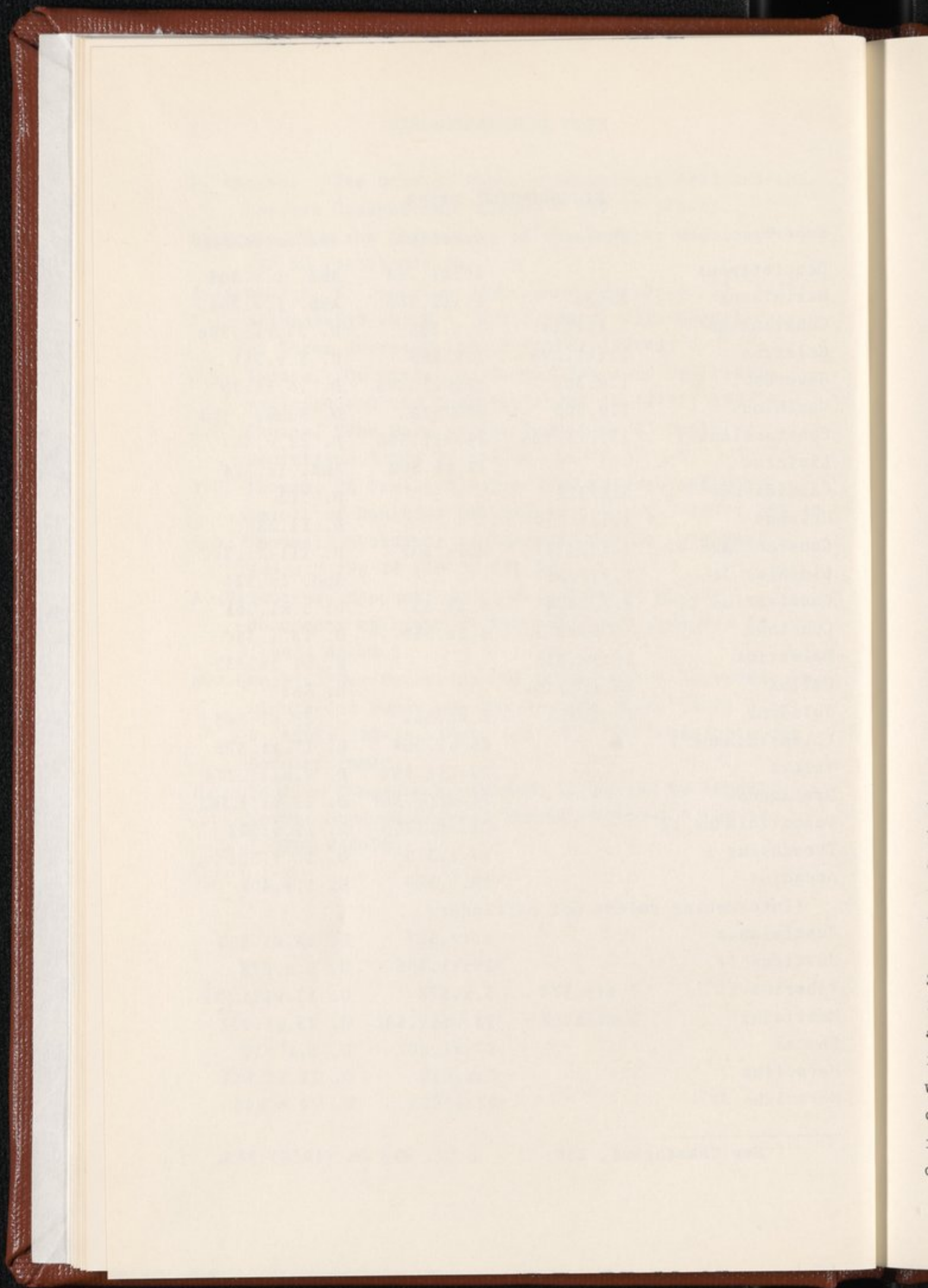

CHAPTER I
THE PERIOD 284-337

Preliminary Note

Citations are arranged in sections for each change of emperors; within each such chronological unit, there are given the attested formulas. For each of them is given the citations, year by year. After all of the formulas for a period comes a section for documents with regnal year numbers assignable to this period but with no formula, arranged again by year.

Citations include both instances of *dates* by a year (e.g., "year 2 of Diocletian, Phaophi 16") and *references* to a year (e.g., "for the crop of year 2 of Diocletian"). In each year the dates to that year are given first; for each we give the exact julian date where known (if none is given, it is not known), the provenance, and any variants in the formula from the standard one under which it is located. References to a year follow; they are identifiable by "d." before the date, to show that the date which follows does not fall in the year referred to. (The references to the crop of the current year in the body of dated documents are treated as if they were dates by the current year.) Provenances are in general given only to the nome, for brevity and clarity of pattern; they are intended to indicate place of writing rather than of finding where these are different.

Where more than one version of the numbering of a given year is attested, references are separated according to the numbering used. Numberings used *only retrospectively*, and never during the year in question, are identified by being put in parentheses (). Year dates without formula of which the attribution to a reign cannot be established with some probability are not included. For single year dates not included here see our discussion in *CNBD* II 12.

CHAPTER II

THE PERIOD 337-537

After the death of Constantinus I in 337, the use of dating by regnal year continued its decline at an accelerated pace. To a large degree this decline reflects the use of consulates for absolute dating to julian years and of the indiction for dating to fiscal years. The use of some sort of civil regnal year reckoning continued, so far as our evidence indicates, only in the Oxyrhynchite and Herakleopolite Nomes. In the Oxyrhynchite we find a system of numbering years by continuing the years of Constantinus I after his death (May, 337), joining to them the regnal years of the currently ruling monarchs. This system continued until the accession of Julianus as junior emperor in 355/6; regnal years of Constantius II and Julianus appear from this time on, until Constantius' death (November, 361) as regnal years, then after his death as a sort of era-year plus Julianus' regnal year, then finally as a pair of eras after the death of Julianus (June, 363). For the evidence, details and a list of documents, the reader is referred to *CSBE* 36-42.¹ These regnal years and era years after 337 *never* have any sort of formula or imperial titulature given with them; they are simply year numbers.

Despite the existence of the Oxyrhynchite eras after 363, true regnal dating—still without formulas—did not quite yet disappear. A few documents of the late fourth

century preserve year numbers attributable to reigning emperors. The peculiarities of the count of regnal years have been discussed elsewhere² and here we need only summarize the evidence. The published documents are as follows:

All but the first and last of these are Oxyrhynchite. Except for papyri of era years 40-9 (i.e. 363/4), immediately after the death of Julianus, era dating first appears in Oxyrhynchos in 53-22 = 376/7 and 56-25 = 379/380, but not otherwise until 63-32 = 386/7.³ It

appears that the era years and regnal dating coexisted, with regnal dating rather the more common, until the mid 380's. But the evidence is not very extensive, and future publications may alter the balance.

The use of Valens' year 16 eight months after his death (9.viii.378) is remarkable; it seems most probable that the news of Valens' death did not reach Egypt until into his 16th year, when a change in the year numbering was considered undesirable and avoided until the next regnal year began. But it is also conceivable that the use represents a new experiment in era-building which was immediately abandoned, or even that the news of his death arrived very late.

One supposed exception to the picture given here of general desuetude of regnal formulas and regnal dating from the later fourth century until Justinian, namely *SB VIII* 9773, has already been eliminated by us as belonging not in 405 but in 540.⁴ Another such problem is posed by *P.Oxy.* XXIV 2408. The editor has restored the following date (line 5):

From what is said above, it is clear that such a restoration in this period is extremely unlikely. But certainly]ουστων must be part of the date: it must in fact be the end of Αὐγ]ούστων, referring to the month of August. The date is thus between 17 ante Kal. Aug. and Id. Aug. (i.e. 16.vii and 13.viii.397).⁵

CHAPTER III
JUSTINIAN (1.iv.527-15.xi.565)

Justinian's Novella 47, on 31.viii.537, ordered that documents were to be dated by regnal year, consulate and indiction. The regnal year was to be calculated from the date of accession of the emperor to the throne; each year began on the anniversary of the accession. The old practice in Egypt of counting the time from accession to the next Epagomenai 5 (or 6) as year 1, then beginning year 2 with Thoth 1, was discarded. The effects of this edict in Egypt were not immediate; a few years passed before regnal dating began to be used. A full discussion of this matter will be found in the article of H.J. Wolff cited on p.x, especially his section (pp.144 ff.) on the history of dating formulas. Not long after, the annual consulate was effectively abolished, with Flavius Basilius (in 541) being the last. From that time on, the consular reckoning was based on the postconsulate of Basilius, or more exactly a postconsular era.

Dating by the postconsular years of Basilius was standard practice in Egypt for the remainder of Justinian's reign, but the abolition of the consulate (except for imperial consulates at the start of reigns) led eventually to the decline of the consulate as a dating device. Under Justinian, however, it still was more important than the use of regnal years. In this connection we must emphasize that *no document of the reign of Justinian is dated solely by the emperor's regnal years*. (A supposed exception is eliminated in CNBD II 20.) In fact, the first document dated only by regnal year and indiction comes from the reign of Justinus II (P.Lond. V 1707), and it is unique in that reign. The next examples come from the reign of Tiberius II (P.Oxy. I 135 and SB VI 9085, inv.16050). The regnal formulas listed below, therefore, must be understood as

only part of a dating formula which invariably included the consul(s) or, after 541, the postconsular era of Basilius.

A few summary conclusions about the formulas may be drawn: (1) the earliest appearance of regnal dating comes in 540, in the Hermopolite. The earliest Herakleopolite example comes from 540, the first Antaiopolite in 543, and Oxyrhynchite in 548 (the provenance of *SB* VI 9239 is certainly Oxyrhynchos, as is shown by the mention of Arcadia and the formula used for the postconsulate of

Basilius). Antinoopolite usage of regnal dating is not attested before 555. The documents from Constantinople naturally do not contribute to the question of the enforcement of Novella 47 in Egypt, but the earlier of the two known examples actually is later than the earliest Hermopolite example known (this is presumably mere chance).

(2) The Middle Egyptian nomes share one uniform formula, which is the same as that in use in Constantinople; those from Upper Egypt all have formula 2, shorter by two words (καὶ εὐσεβεστάτου).

CHAPTER IV
JUSTINUS II (15.xi.565-5.x.578)

There are several varieties of dating formulas under the emperor Justinus II, combining in various fashions the regnal years and consular or postconsular years of the emperor.

Comment: This papyrus, dated solely to the consulate of Justinus, comes from the actual year of the consulate. This formula is not found later.

ANTINOOPOLITE *P. Stras.* I 46-47 (17.iii.566; presumably 48-51, part of the same roll and dated the same day, had this formula also; their tops are lost; see *BASP* 15 [1978]). *P. Lond.* V 1707 (5.x.566; βασιλείας rest. and no consulate or p.c. follows, an unparalleled situation for this reign; but space does not permit formula 3. Rest. of consulate instead of regnal formula made unlikely by usage of epithets).

Comment: The Strasbourg dossier comes presumably from the time before the consulate of Justinus was announced in Antinoopolis, and the postconsular era of Basilius was still used. They are in fact our only surviving papyri from the first half of 566.

All examples of this formula are listed in *CSBE*, Appendix D, under years 566-576/577, as formulas 2A (only θειοτάτου) and 2B (both epithets); there are 37 examples of 2A, 5 of 2B. It should be observed that form 2A, the shorter form, is found in all parts of Egypt from which we have documents (Antinoopolite, Hermopolite, and Antaiopolite; *SB* 4796 is only dubiously attributed to the Arsinoite) except Oxyrhynchos, whereas form 2B, which adds καὶ εὐσεβεστάτου, is found only in Oxyrhynchos and further is found in all of the documents we have from that town between 566 and 568 (i.e., *PSI* VI 709, *P.Lond.* III 775 and 778, *P.Oxy.* VII 1038, and *PSI* I 58 [see *CNBD* II 27]). All of these documents come from the period before Justinus' second consulate in 568 was known in Egypt; after that time, formula 4 below (*CSBE* formula 3) was used in Oxyrhynchos. Of the shorter, non-Oxyrhynchite formula, the last certainly datable example known is *P.Lond.* III 1326a, of 25.ix.576. Two further examples of this formula (not listed in *CSBE*) are probably to be found in unrestored or wrongly restored documents, namely *P.Ross.Georg.* V 32 (see *CNBD* II 23) and *P.Bad.* II 30 (1.i-25.iv.578; see *CNBD* II 16).

Comment: This formula is *CSBE*, Appendix D, years 569-578, formula 3. It is exclusively an Oxyrhynchite phenomenon (cf. formula 3 above). The reference to the second consulate of Justinus is constant even in years after the actual year of the consulate.

This formula is found only on one gravestone, *SB* IV 7319 (after 6.vii.574; cf. *BL* V 99-100; but perhaps Euthalios, mentioned first, actually died later (9.x.574) and Maria earlier (6.vii.574). The need to assume an error would thus be eliminated.). Such a regnal formula is never found in the papyri.

- (8) Formula uncertain

PROVENANCE UNKNOWN *P.Lond.* III 1304b (descr., p. lxxii) (566/7; we have seen a photostat).

Finally, it should be mentioned that some papyri of Justinus add to his formula a mention of Tiberius II, who was his co-regent during the last years of his reign. The reference to Tiberius II appears added to various of the formulas listed above, not always making it clear that Tiberius' years in question were regnal and not consular. A summary list follows (for the formulas see Chapter V below):

It is interesting that although Tiberius became co-regent in 574, his first appearance in the papyri as a ruler comes in 576 or 577. It is also noteworthy that several papyri dating after his appointment as co-regent omit him, viz. *PSI* III 242 (30.viii-15.xi.575), *P.Lond.* III 1326a (25.ix.576), *P.Flor.* I 15 and *P.Bad.* II 30 (6.iv and 1.i-25.iv.578). Not all of these, however, come after the date at which Tiberius first actually appears in Egyptian documents. No consistent usage is thus visible.

CHAPTER V
TIBERIUS II (7.xii.574-13.viii.582)

A. Co-Regency of Justinus II and Tiberius II
(7.xii.574-5.x.578)

Eight published documents include Tiberius II in the dating formula of Justinus II during the latter's lifetime. These are listed above (p.53). They have various formulas tagged onto the end of Justinus'. These are as follows:

B. Tiberius' II as Sole Emperor (5.x.578-14.viii.582)

The beginning of Tiberius' reign is normally counted by scribes from the date of his appointment as co-regent with Justinus II, i.e. 7.xii.574. Two documents, however, do not use this counting point, *SB* VI 9085 inv. 16050 (8.ix.579) and *P.Lond.* V 1725 (6.iii.580). Bell pointed out that the London text's date could be explained on the

assumption that the scribe was reckoning from Tiberius' accession to sole power (6.x.578). It seems also possible to us that the numbering in these two texts results from confusion with or identification with the consular dating of Tiberius; cf. *CNBD* V 62.

The following formulas are found under Tiberius' sole reign:

as Τιβέριος ὁ Νέος Κωνσταντῖνος. At Syene, the Arsinoite
form is found twice, and a formula calling him just
Tiberius, once. At Oxyrhynchus, we find under the co-
regency Τιβέριος ὁ καὶ Νέος Κωνσταντῖνος; but in his sole
rule we find in every case but one simply Τιβέριος
Κωνσταντῖνος; only *P.Oxy.* XVI 1892 adds the Νέος.

CHAPTER VIII

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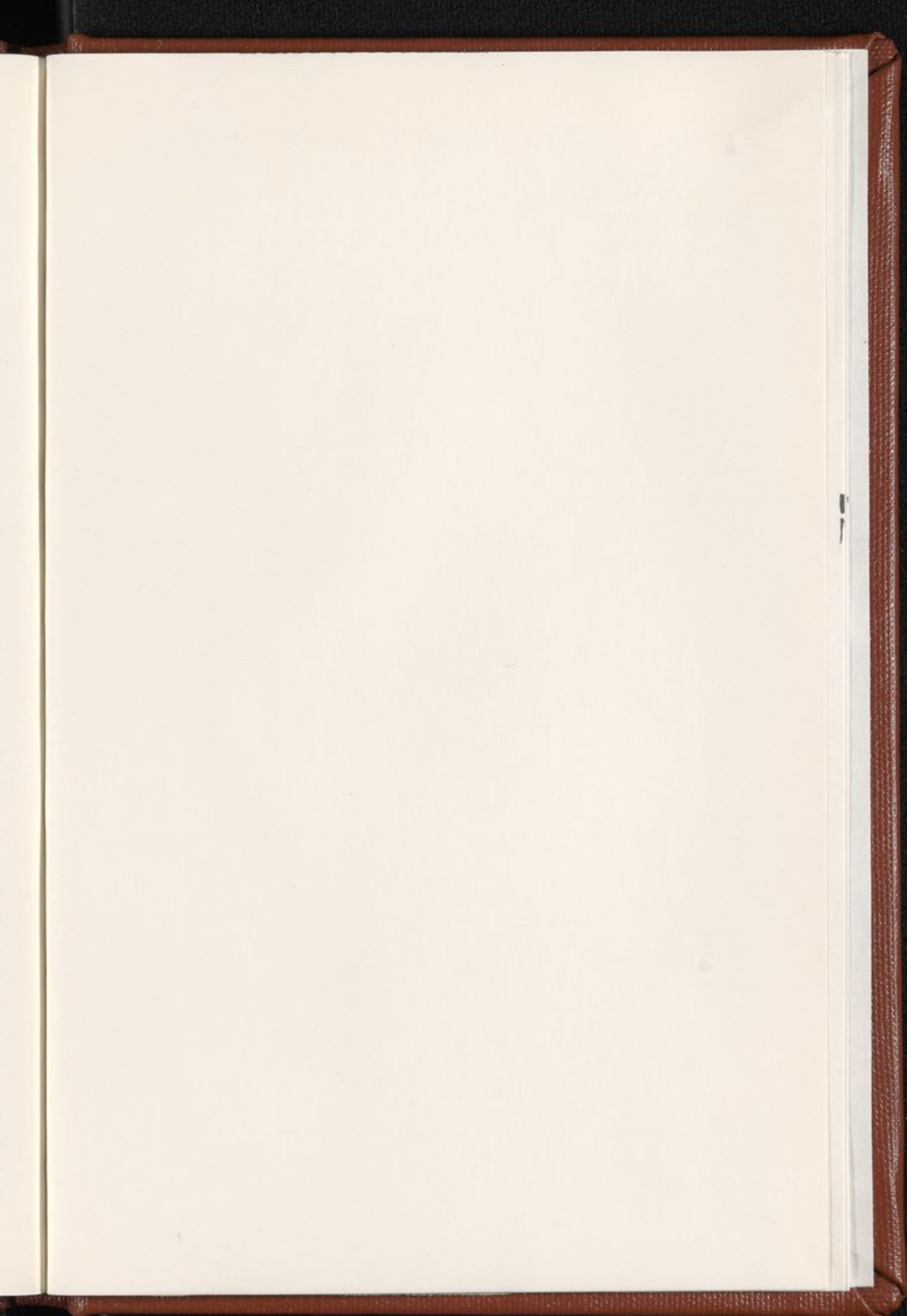
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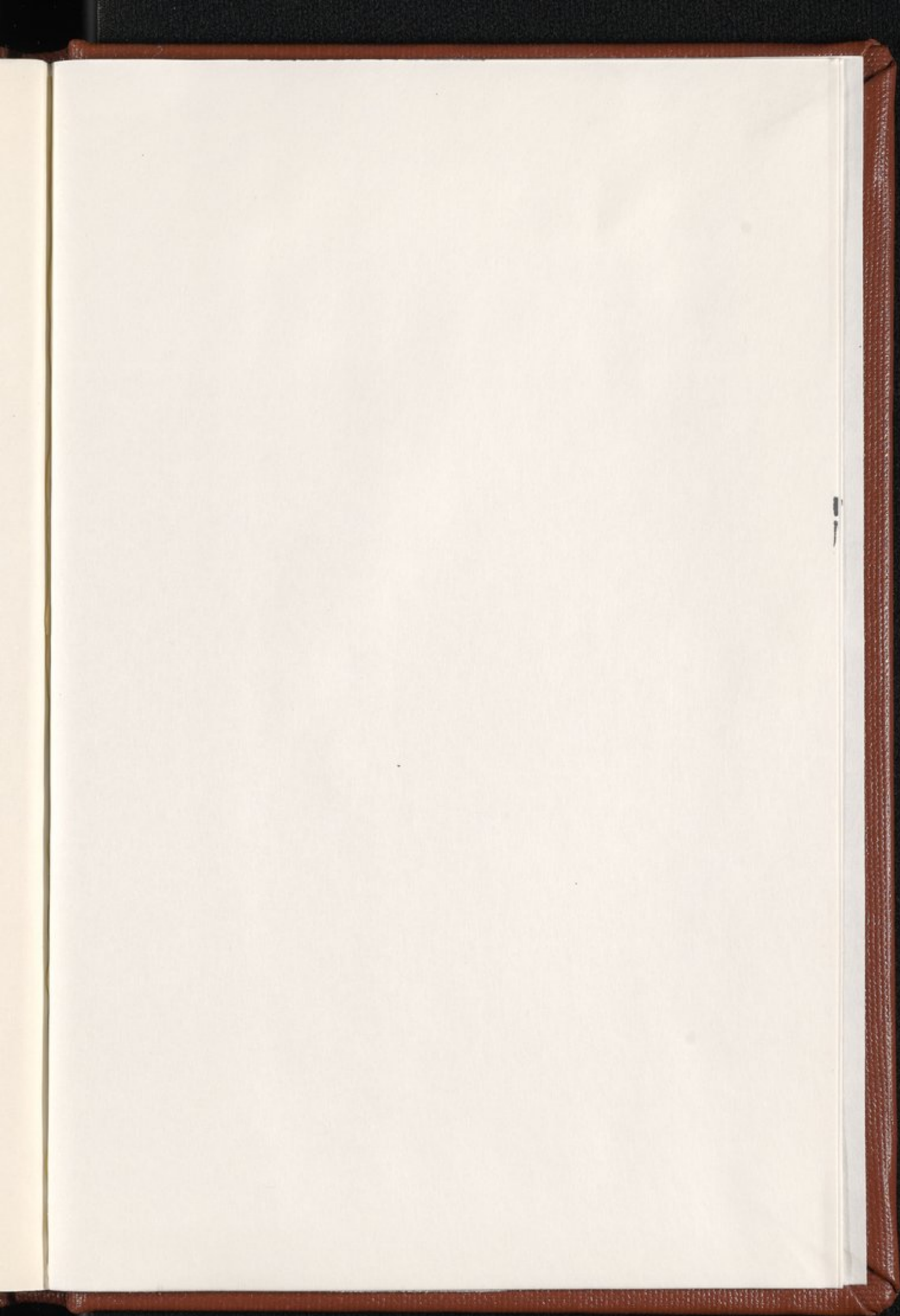
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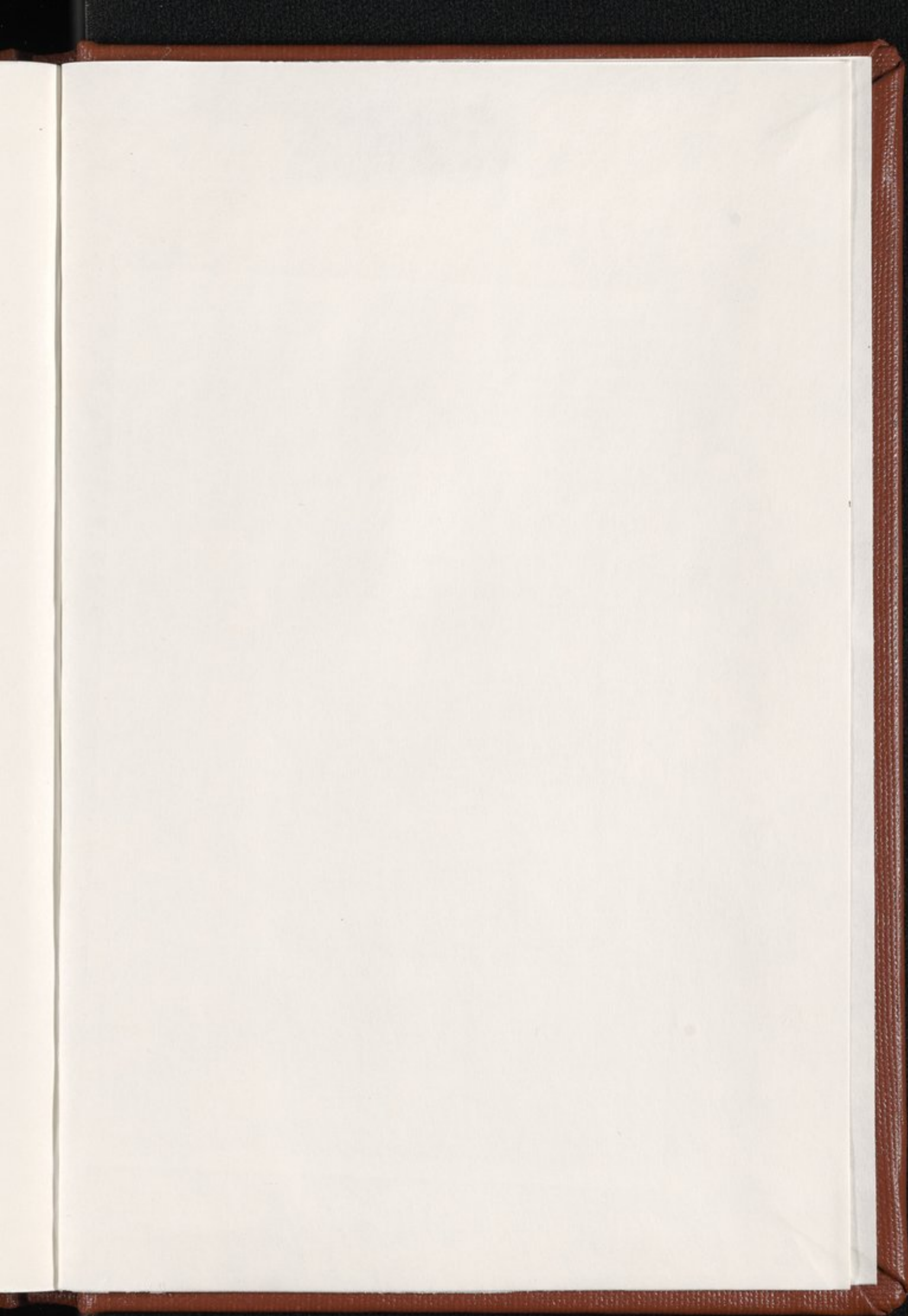


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
